

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Our students rely on the generosity of the community to make a NativityMiguel education possible. They love visitors and welcome your help. Your presence and your good example can make a significant difference to their future success. Some current opportunities include:

- Tutor students in reading or math or provide homework help either one-on-one or in small groups during after school study hall.
 - St. Augustine Campus (boys)
 2:00 nm 4:00 nm on Monday and/o
 - 3:00 pm 4:00 pm on Monday and/or Friday
 - St. Monica Campus (girls) 3:30 pm – 4:30 pm on Monday and/or Friday
- Provide one-on-one or small group help during regular school hours to students struggling with reading or Math. For example, a volunteer who works with one of our refugee students during the period following lunch has significantly improved the student's English language skills.
 - Date and time depends on your interest and availability.
- Lego Club: we have plenty of Legos waiting to benefit from the creativity of our students.
 - St. Augustine Campus (boys) 4:00 pm to 4:30 pm once a week, ideally on Friday
- Start a school chorus or choir. The Daughters of Music are self-taught. Just think how our students would blossom with some additional adult assistance. From past experience, this works best if scheduled during one of our regular class periods.
 - Once a week or once or twice a month at a mutually convenient time between 9:00 am and 2:45 pm with either the boys or the girls.
- Board of Trustees Committees on Communications, Education, Facilities, Finance or Advancement: Committee members provide an invaluable service to the school.
 - Each committee meets once a month on dates and times selected by committee members, often at the beginning or end of the regular business day.
