Our planned giving society is named in memory of Reverend Francis Jann, whose generous bequest has in Father Jann's words, helped in the continuation of NativityMiguel's "marvelous work in educating young people."

Raised in South Buffalo, Father Jann was a graduate of St. Joseph's Collegiate Institute and earned degrees at Christ the King Seminary then at St. Bonaventure University. He was ordained in Buffalo in 1947 by Bishop John O'Hara.

Father Jann was perhaps best known as a beloved priest to the people of St. Patrick and St. Mark Parishes in rural Allegany County where he served until 2011 when, at the age of 89, he officially retired after more than 64 years of service. His tenure as an active priest was one of the longest ever in the Diocese of Buffalo.

Father Jann retired to Brothers of Mercy Nursing Home in Clarence, where he continued to serve the faithful until his death.

He remains an inspiration to the NativityMiguel students and staff who had the honor of knowing Father Jann in his retirement.
