Dear Parents and Students,

School is one place you have known that your child is cared for, safe and loved, where she gets a quality education. We want to make sure your daughter's education continues as much as possible during this time. In order to best serve you we have come up with mandatory work which must be completed and returned to school when we return on April 20th.

We are also including some websites that will be fun, and helpful during this time. Parents, please encourage your child to do her best on the workbooks, and to do additional work online when possible. The workbook will be worth 100 points, per day, per class. Any incomplete work will result in potential failure of the fourth quarter of school. Completed, it has the potential to help your daughter have a wonderful start to the 4th quarter! Again, this work is NOT optional, it is mandatory, it MUST be completed for the first day back.

We are requiring each student to complete 4 workbook pages a day, which consists of the four core subjects. For example, on March 16, 2020, your daughter is responsible to complete day 1 and day 2 (pages 3-6). Continue each day so that she ends on page 90. Your daughter may use the internet for help with the work - example: google definitions of words, use of an online atlas, math help, and more. I highly recommend Khan Academy, BrainPop, and Scholastic for help in all subject areas, extra practice and fun activities and videos.

Please note: GREAT NEWS Spectrum is offering free wifi to all families with students who do not already have Spectrum. Also, if you are behind in your bills, they will not cancel and will waive fees for the next 60 days. SPECTRUM - 1-844-488-8395.

Any additional work completed, if handed in, will get extra credit points.

Parents, please make sure your child sticks to a routine. Limit screen time and social media. Have your child use normal school time to watch educational videos, do the assigned work, read a book, practice basic math facts, practice spelling skills, write stories about their days at home, write poetry, create art, be creative.
